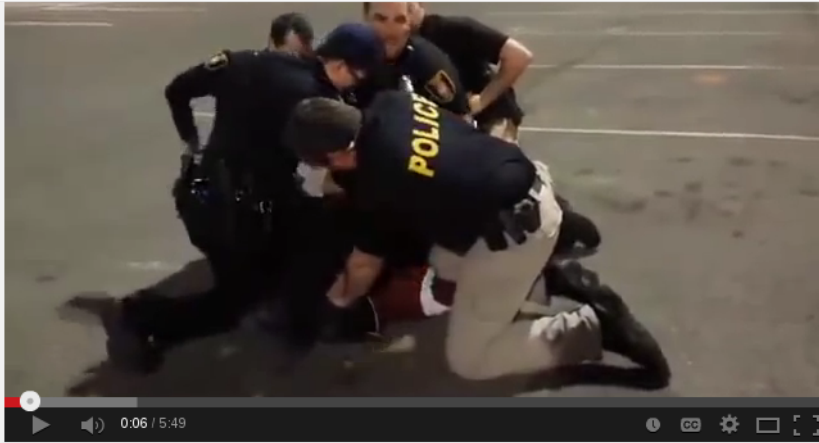


Random Terrorism From North American Police
