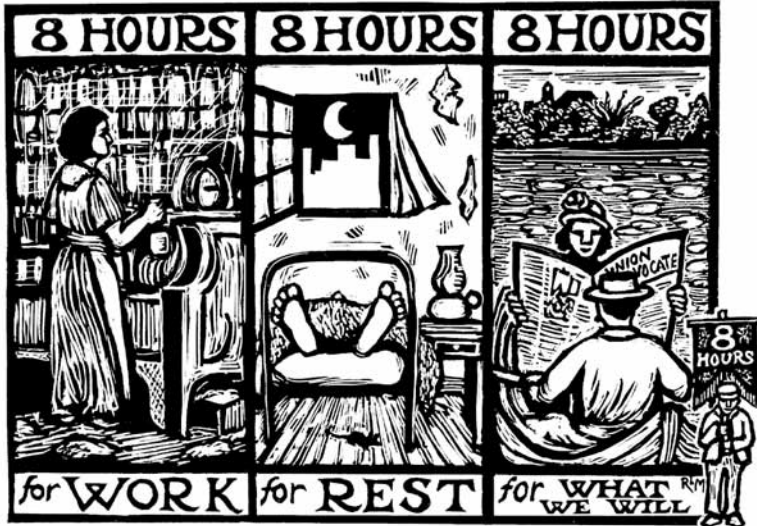


What Occupy Vancouver Could Look Like
